End of quarantine public health briefing

WHAT: Federal and Riverside County public health officials will provide an update on the end of the federal quarantine, which has kept 195 evacuees from Wuhan, China in a cordoned area of March Air Reserve Base (MARB). The quarantine was in place to prevent the spread of the 2019 novel coronavirus.

WHO: Rear Admiral Dr. Nancy Knight, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Dr. Cameron Kaiser, Riverside County Public Health Officer

WHEN: Feb. 11 at noon

WHERE: March Field Air Museum

Parking lot 22550 Van Buren Blvd., Riverside, CA, 92518

MORE: After completing the 14-day quarantine, the evacuees will leave the March Air Reserve Base starting Feb. 11. There are no confirmed cases of the 2019 novel coronavirus in Riverside County, including among the 195 evacuees at MARB. This press availability will be live-streamed from the Riverside University Health System-Public Health's Facebook page.
