



Figure 5: Fatal Overdoses by Gender 2022






Figure 6: Overdose Deaths by Region







Figure 7: Count Overdose Deaths* among People Experiencing Homelessness by Year - January 2019-October 2022

Figure 10: Type of Drugs* Involved in Fatal Overdoses by Age





Figure 11: Fatal Overdoses by Race / Ethnicity and Drug Type *




Figure 13: Count of Drug-Related Emergency Department Visits by Age (All Drugs) December 2022





Figure 14: Count of All Drug VS Opioid-Related Visits To the Emergency Department January 1, 2022 - December 31, 2022
