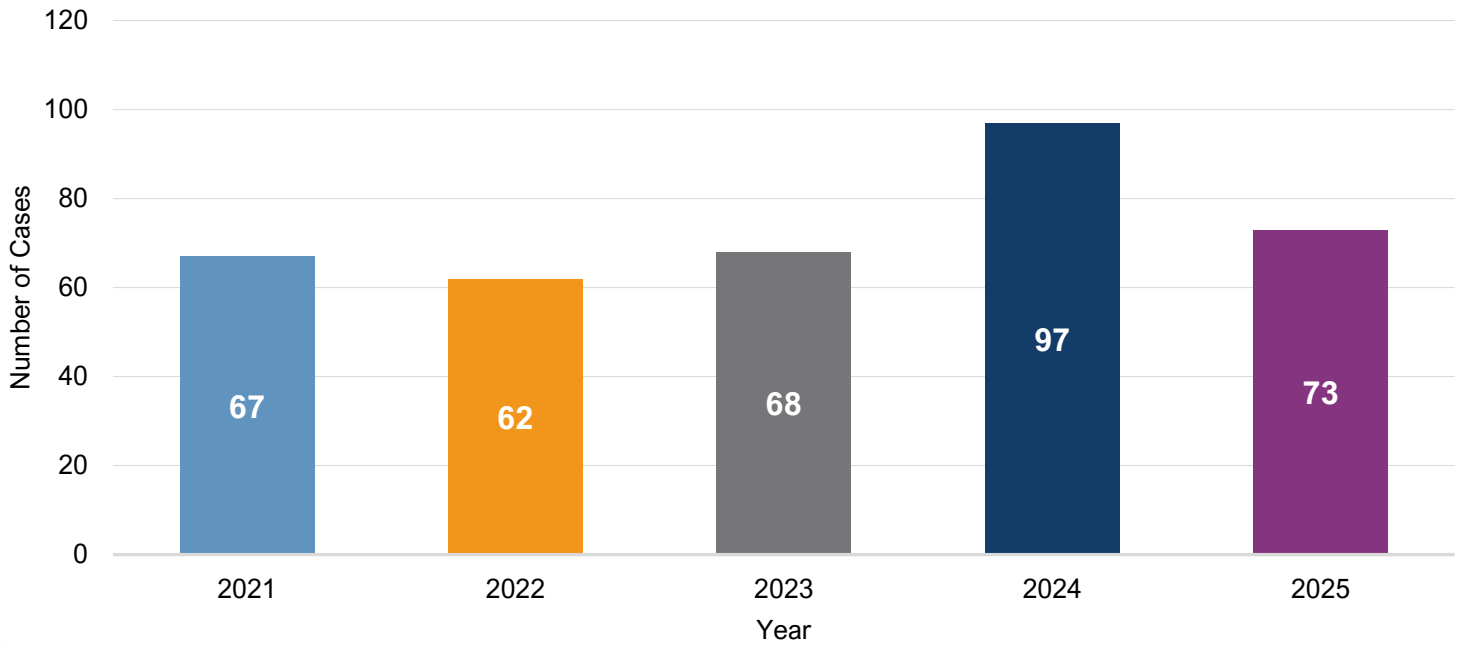
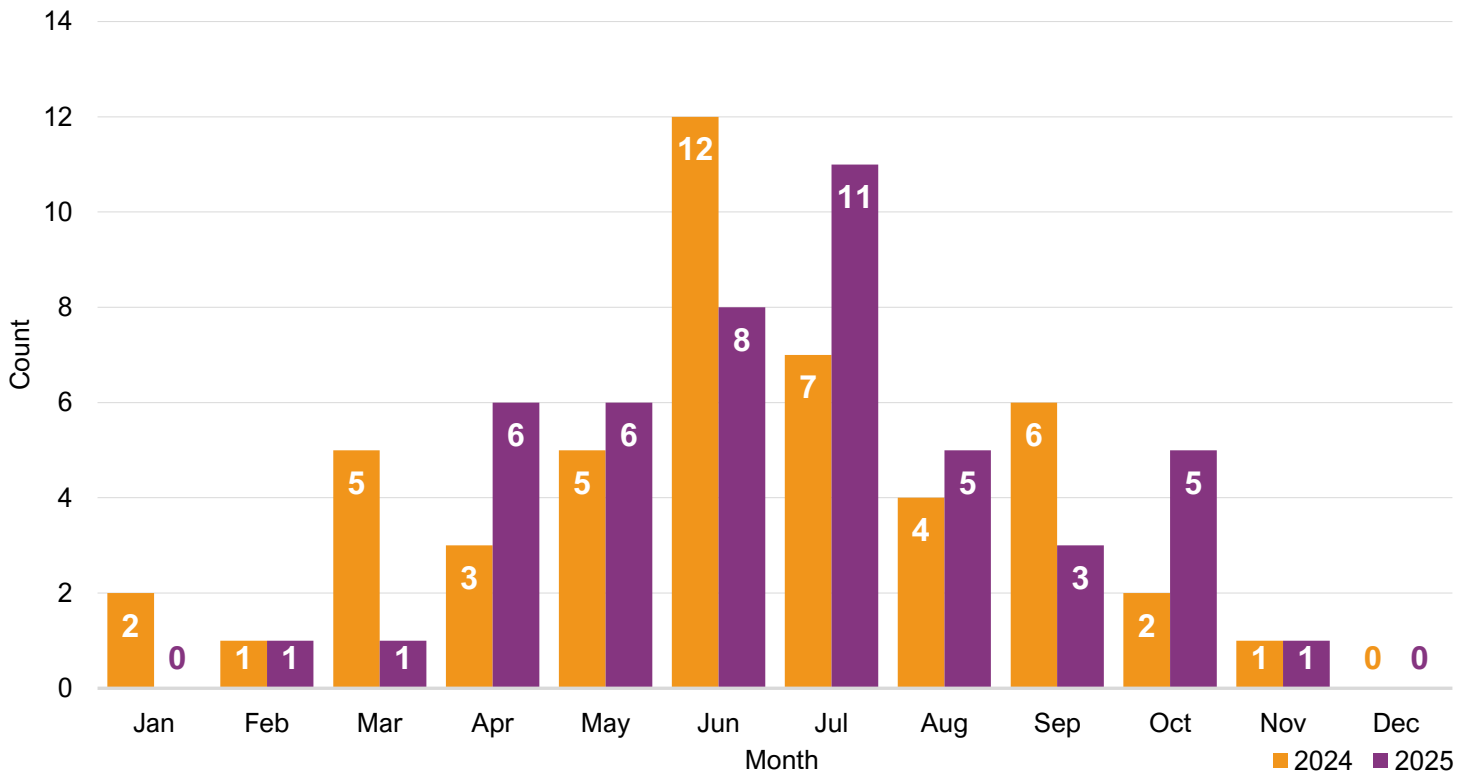


Active Tuberculosis Cases in Riverside County (2021-2025)

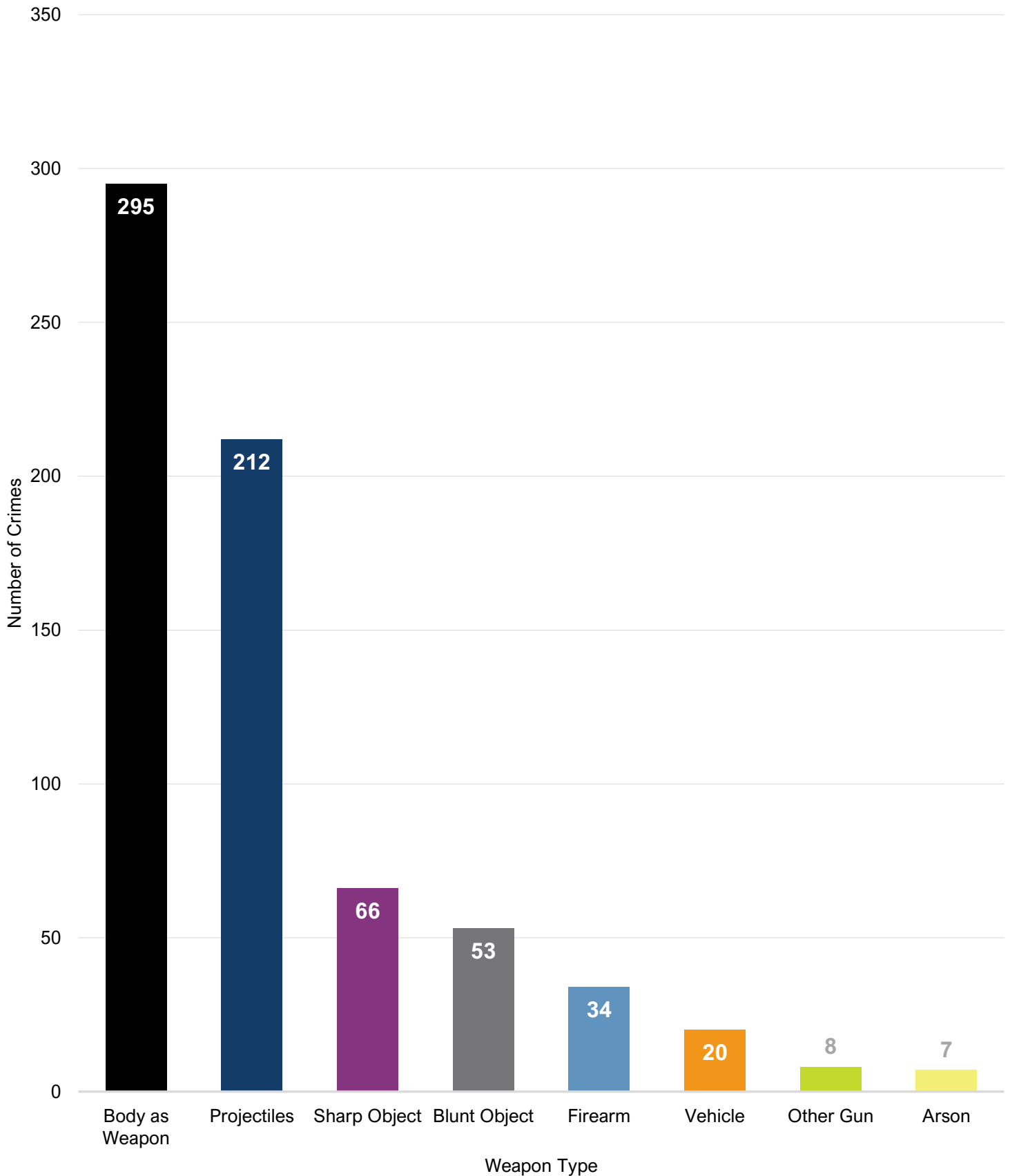
911 Calls for Drowning Incidents (0-5 years) Peak in Summer Months, Riverside County (2024-2025)

Hate Crimes by Weapon Type: Riverside County 2001-2024



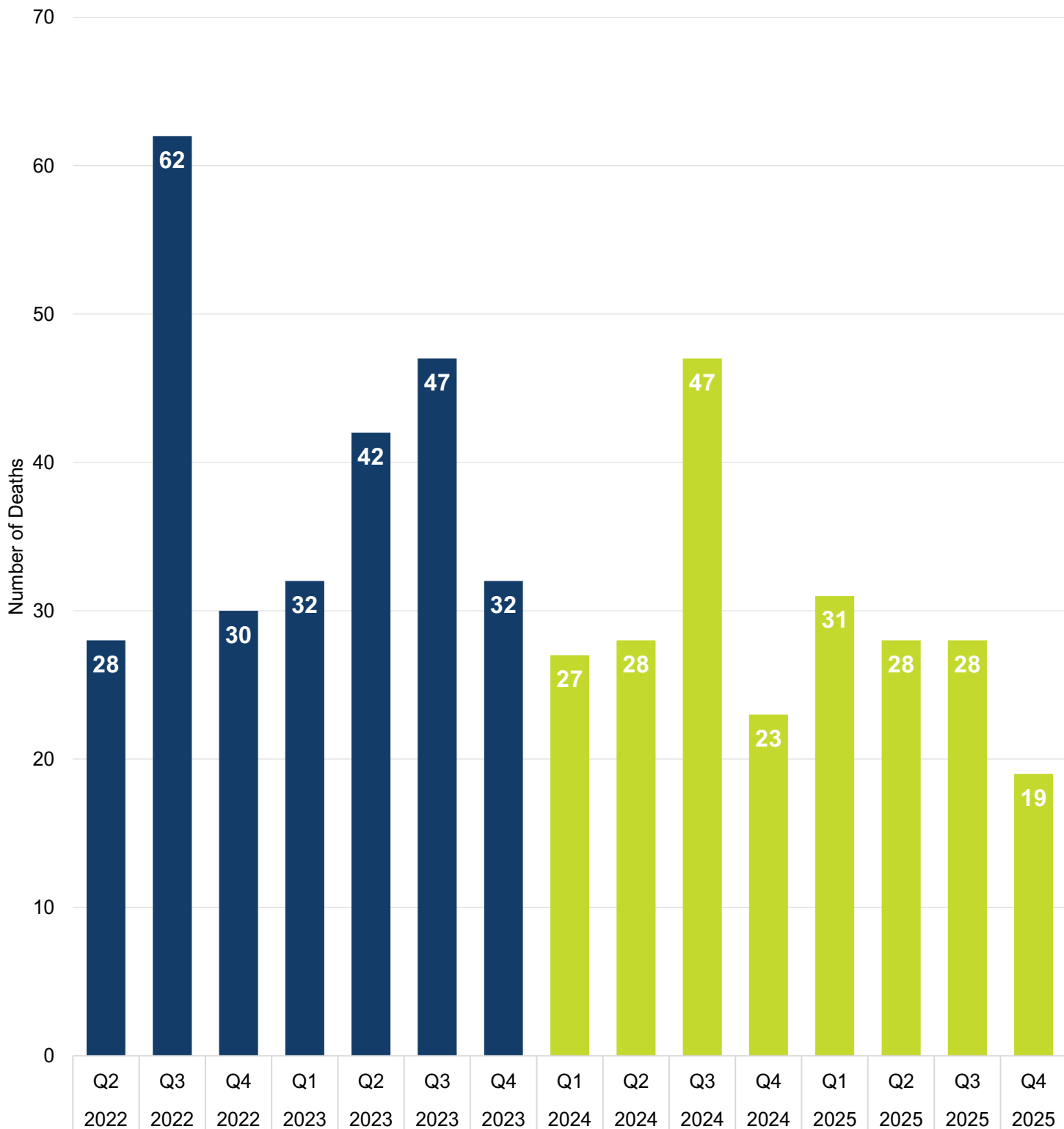
