Meza is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Biobehavioral Sciences and a bilingual licensed clinical psychologist at UCLA. She directs the Youth Stress and Mood (YSAM) Program and founded the Health Equity & Access Research & Treatment (HEART) Lab. Her research focuses on suicide prevention and culturally responsive interventions for young people. Trained in cognitive-behavioral and dialectical behavior therapies at UC Berkeley and UCSF, Dr. Meza has extensive experience training mental health providers in evidence-based suicide interventions in California and New York.
