WHAT IS THE INDIO CRISIS CENTER?

The Indio Crisis Center is a 24/7 walk-in, immediate behavioral health facility providing crisis assessments and crisis intervention to individuals as young as 5 years old experiencing a behavioral health crisis or urgent need. Our centers are staffed by behavioral health professionals who are trained to evaluate and stabilize individuals in crisis.

By delivering comprehensive, round-the-clock care and support, the crisis center helps individuals regain stability to transition back into the community. We offer a range of services including crisis intervention, psychiatric and therapeutic services, substance use counseling, peer support, case management, and referrals to other community resources as needed.

Crisis Intervention

Immediate crisis assessment and stabilization for those in a behavioral health and substance use disorder crisis.

Peer Engagement & Support

Non-clinical service that provides support to overall treatment that provides validation to individuals in recovery through lived experience.

Clinical Assessment and Crisis Counseling

Comprehensive assessments to determine unique needs of each client. Provide evidenced-based counseling techniques tailored to each individual during their crisis.

Medication Support

Medication services include Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) for substance use disorders, with staff collaborating with clients to determine and adjust medications as needed.

Establishment of a Personal Safety Plan

Collaborate with clients to create personalized safety plans that address their risks and triggers, offering coping strategies and supportive contacts to empower their well-being.

Immediate Crisis Response

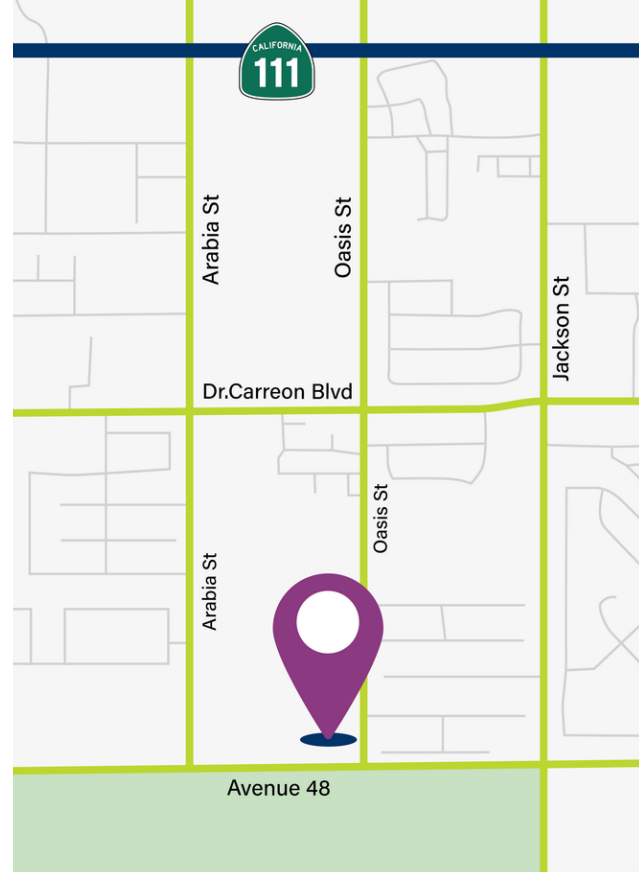
Ensure immediate support for community members facing behavioral health crises by providing a dedicated center for urgent care, enabling timely interventions and preventing harm.

Prevention of Escalation

The Indio Crisis Center addresses behavioral health issues early to prevent crises from escalating into hospitalizations or justice involvement.

The crisis center serves individuals as young as 5, ensuring vulnerable populations, including children and adolescents, get timely care. This accessibility fosters youth resilience and enhances the community's behavioral health.
