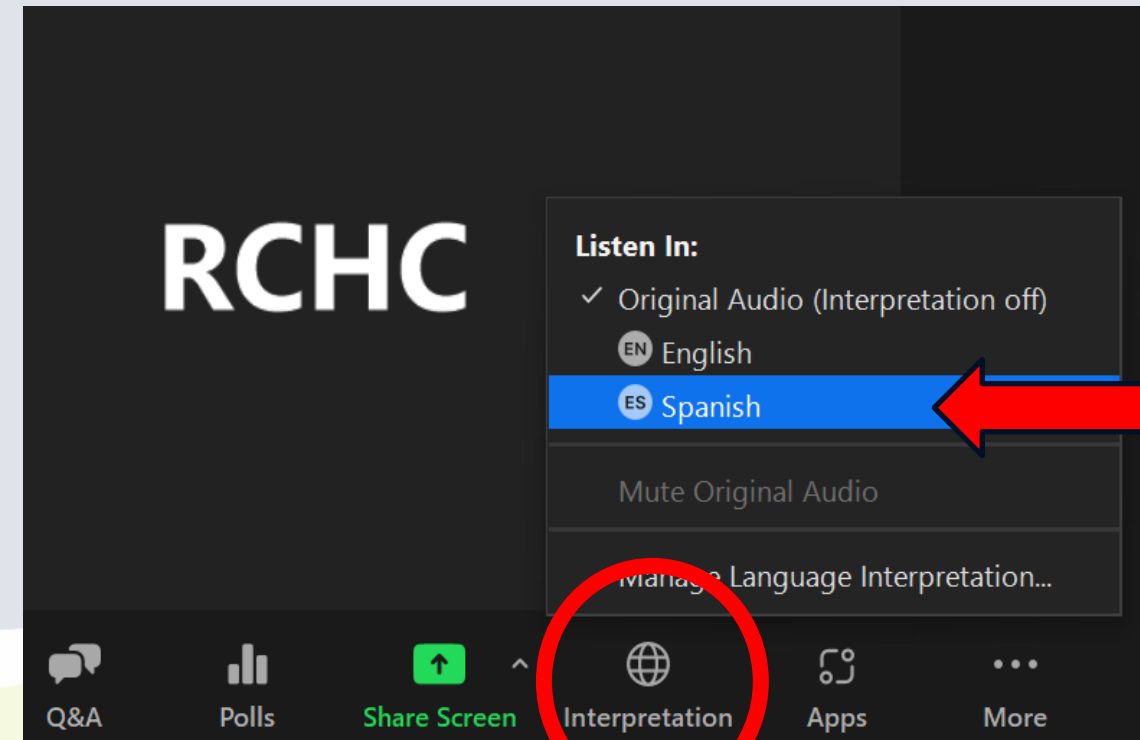

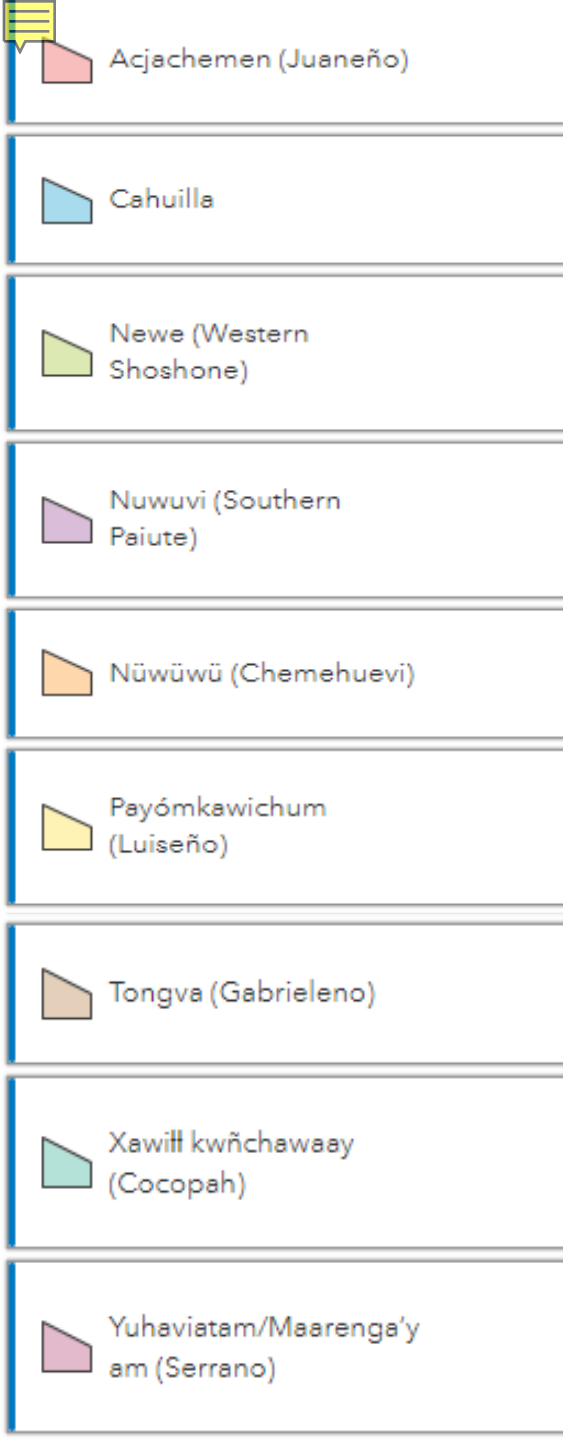

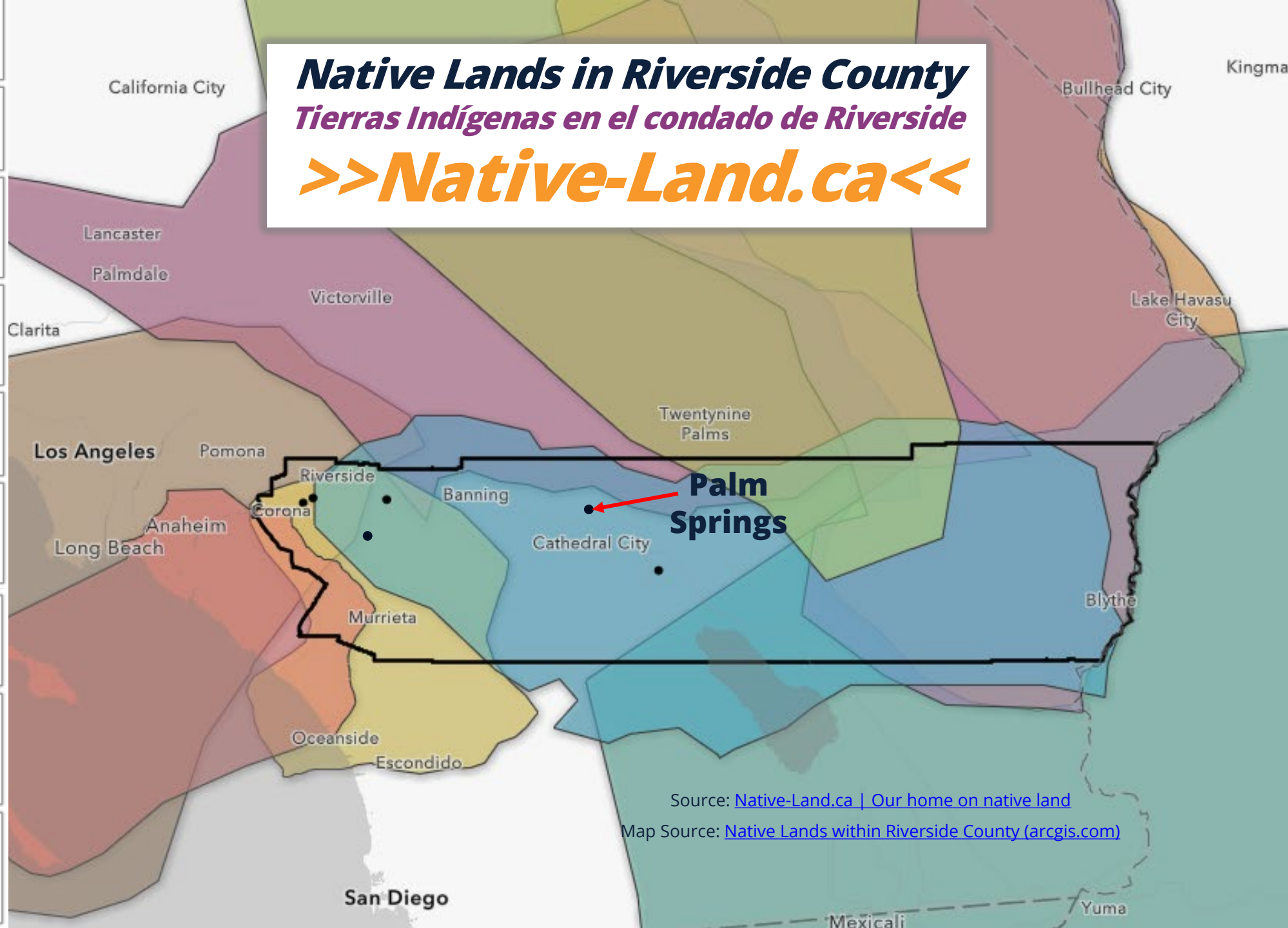

Land Acknowledgment

The Riverside University Health System – Public Health, Health Equity program acknowledges the traditional, ancestral, and contemporary homelands of the Indigenous Peoples of Riverside County whose land we occupy. The Iviatem (Cahuilla), Payómkawichum (Luiseño), Maara'yam (Serrano), Nuwuvi (Chemehuevi), and Tongva (Gabrieleño) peoples have been the caretakers of this land, water, and air since time immemorial.

Indigenous Peoples have been forcefully displaced or relocated and colonization is ongoing with their lands still occupied due to the dishonest illusion of promised treaties. The Health Equity program commits to practicing cultural humility and reciprocity, respecting, and supporting the tribal sovereignty, culture, and beliefs of Indigenous Peoples of Riverside County and beyond.

We hope to build an honest, ongoing relationship with Indigenous Peoples in Riverside County as we learn from their vast experiences. We recognize that there have been past injustices and aim to move toward reconciliation with good intentions and respect. We challenge you to join us in this work. If you are unaware of whose land you are currently occupying, we encourage you to learn about the Indigenous Peoples in your area, their history and ongoing resilience.

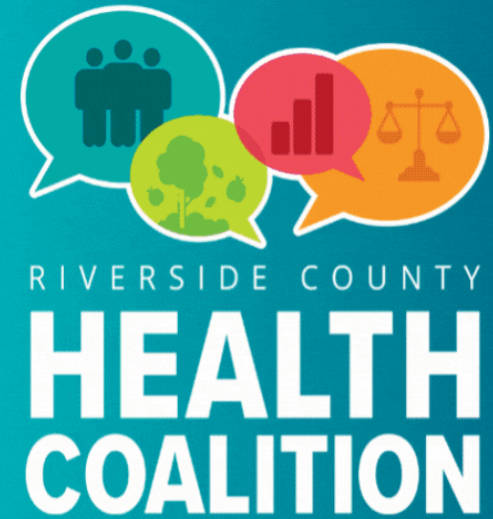
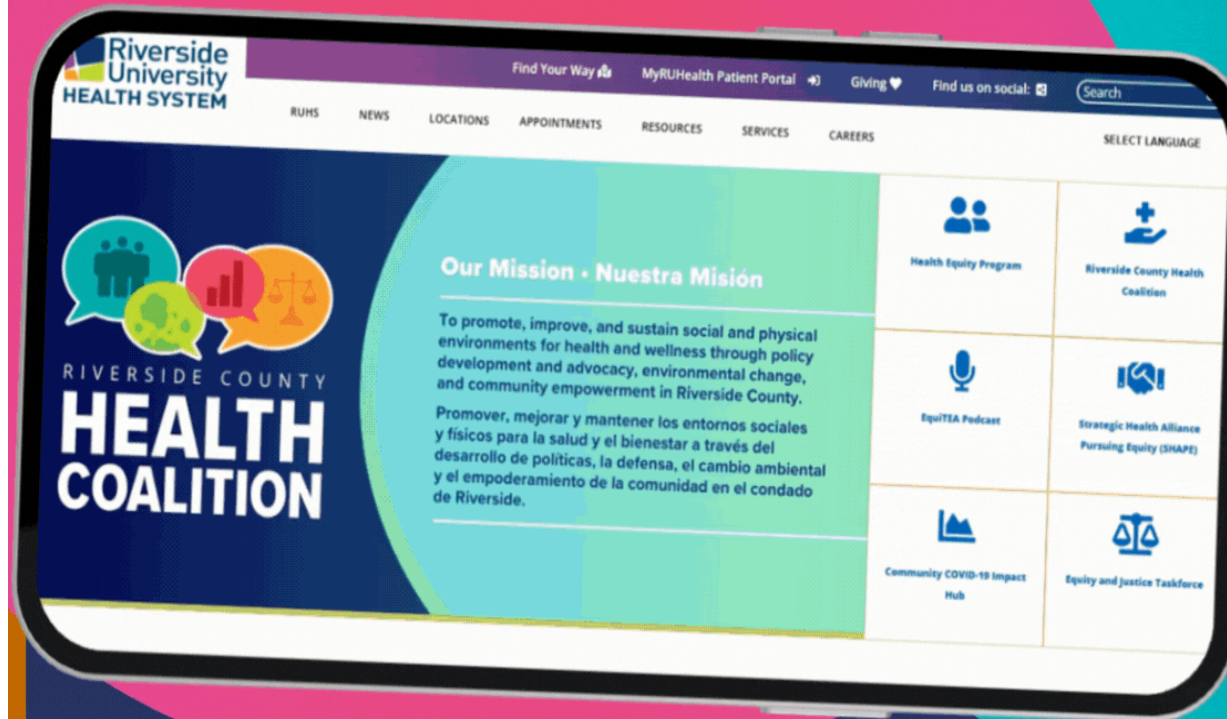

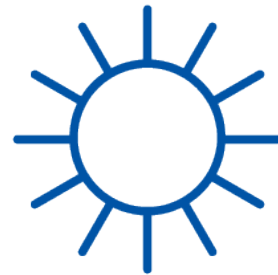

Reduce rent burden in the Coachella Valley by 30% through the production of **10,000 affordable housing units by 2028.**

The Problem We Are Solving

Riverside County's prosperity rests on the backs of workers who can no longer afford to live here.

- **54,000+ low-income renters countywide lack affordable homes**, and 78% of ELI households spend more than half their income on rent (CA Housing Partnership, 2025).
- RivCo renters must earn **\$38/hour**, 2.3x the state minimum wage, to afford the average rent (CA Housing Partnership, 2025).
- **Chronic underinvestment** plus lack of density and public transportation infrastructure leaves Riverside County's housing projects **uncompetitive for state funding**, despite urgent need and a deficit of housing supply compounded over decades.
- **Low wages for the tourism, agriculture, and warehousing workforce** leaves the workers who power our economy underpaid and increasingly destabilized by housing costs.

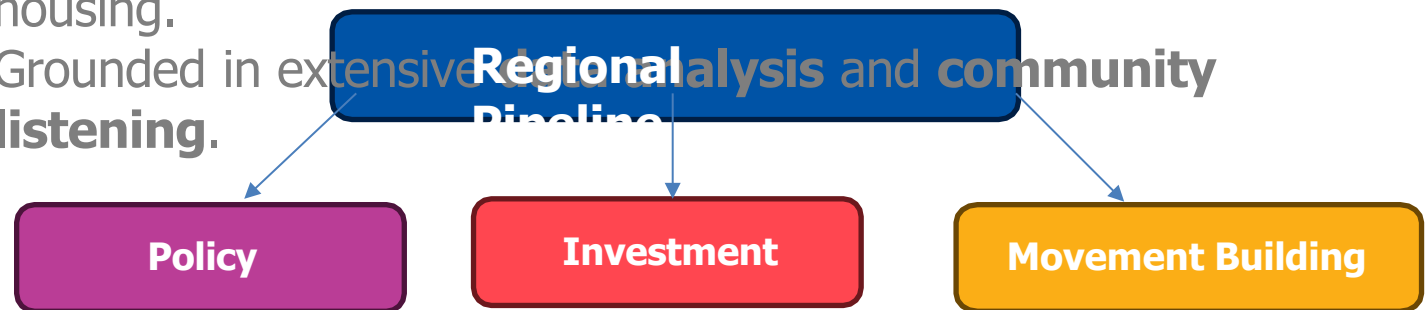


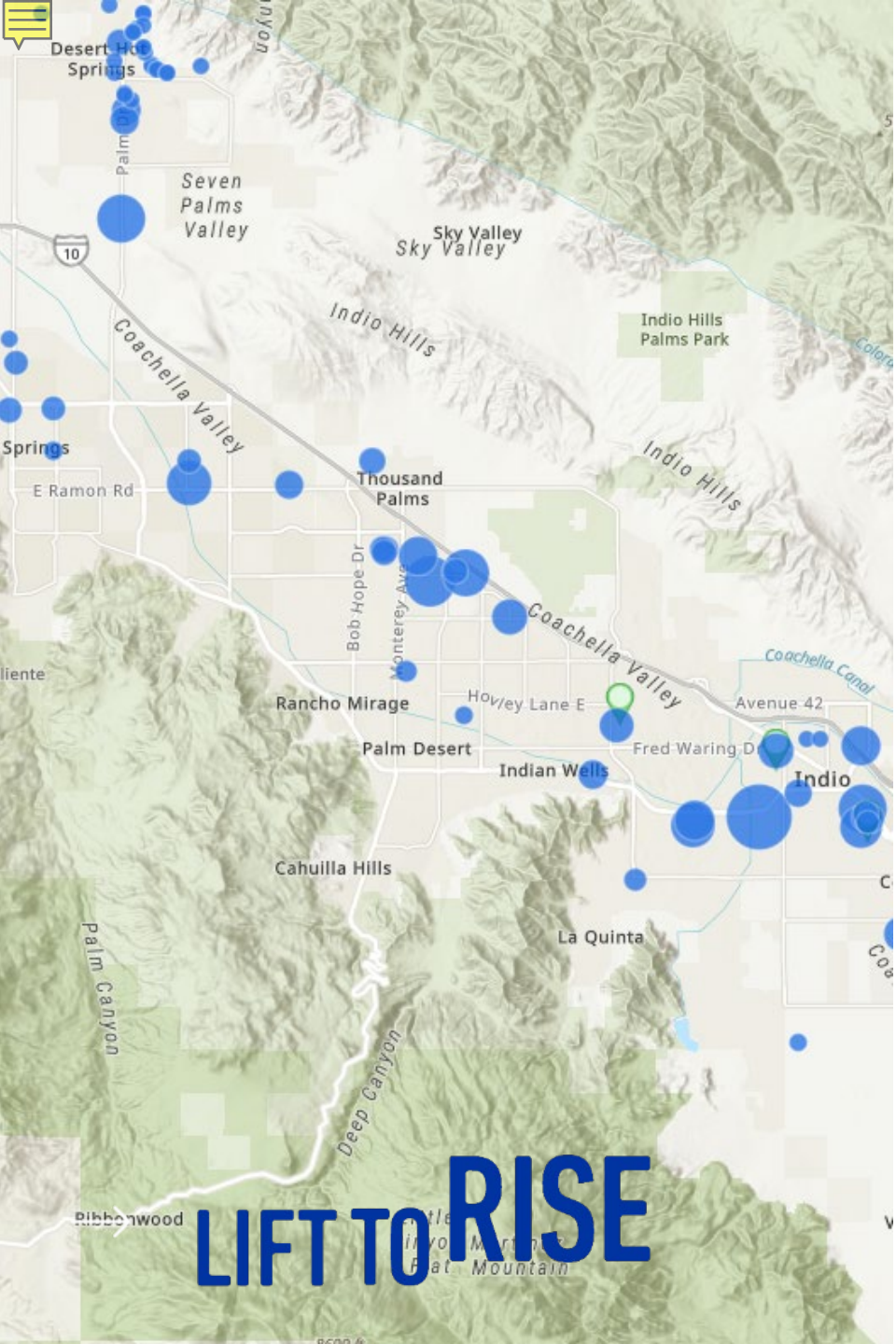
LIFT TO RISE

How We Are Solving It

Capital Absorption, Collective Impact, and Public-Private Partnership:

- Lift to Rise is **backbone organization** of collective impact initiative
- **70+ cross-sector partners in our Housing Collaborative Action Network, and Resident Leadership Table:** Riverside County, local cities, affordable housing developers, community residents, CBOs, funders, CDFIs, utilities
- All organized around our **shared goal** implementing a regional, **multi-pronged pipeline, policy, investment, and movement building** agenda.
- Together we have built the **We Lift Catalyst Fund**, an investment vehicle that drives capital to community prioritized housing.
- Grounded in extensive **community listening.**

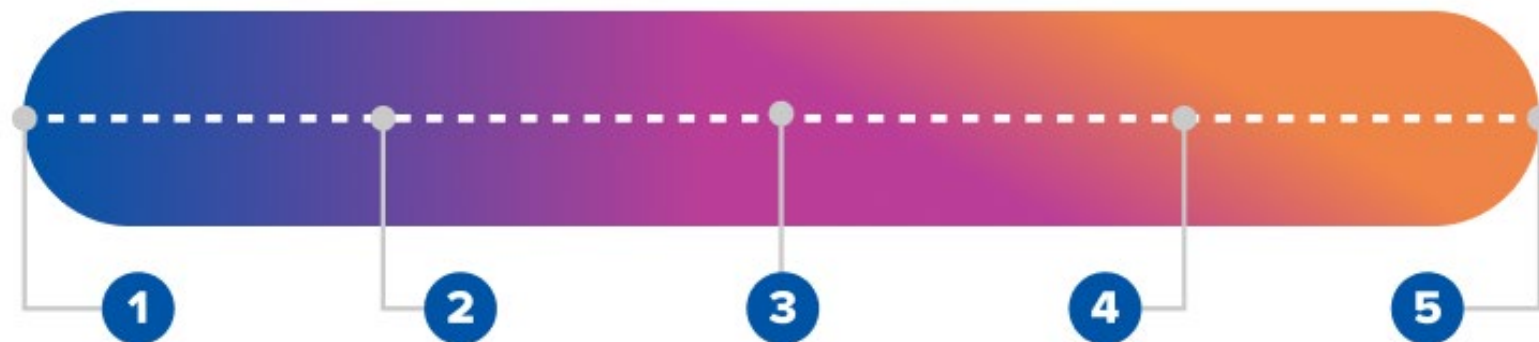

We Lift Catalyst Fund – How It Works



- 1 Lift to Rise tracks a pipeline of proposed affordable housing projects and identifies level of investment needed to fill pipeline-wide financing gaps
- 2 Lift to Rise raises pool of public, private, and philanthropic capital, targeting level of pipeline investment needed
- 3 Lift to Rise partners with non-profit lenders Low Income Investment Fund and RCAC, who match Lift to Rise capital and underwrite loans for qualifying pipeline projects
- 4 Developers use loans to move projects forward and eventually pay back loans to the Fund
- 5 The Fund issues new loans to additional pipeline projects using recycled capital

The program strengthens residents' advocacy skills by helping them understand the root causes of the housing crisis and equipping them with practical tools to act in their communities. **By the end, participants are prepared to organize, mobilize, and use their voices to influence housing policy.**





Impact by the Numbers

- **Radical Production Increase**: From 38 units/year pre-2018 to **1,400+ units/year under construction**, with 9,300+ units in the pipeline.
- **Catalyst Fund Savings**: Flexible, below-market interest rates reduce financing costs, generating **millions in project savings**.
- **Leveraged Resources**: For every dollar deployed from the Catalyst Fund, an estimated **\$6.88 in private investment** and **\$15.65 in total investment** (including public funds) are leveraged.
- **Rental Assistance**: Our emergency pandemic response kept **35,000 households** housed during the pandemic.
- **Resident Centered Leadership**: **Thousands of residents mobilized** in city council, planning commission, and state/federal advocacy spaces to directly shape housing outcomes.

In a state with a dire affordable housing shortage, does the Coachella Valley offer hope?



When it opens this summer, Aloe Palm Canyon will become the latest addition to the Coachella Valley's growing stock of affordable housing.

Systems Impact

- **Economic Impact**: Each affordable housing development generates hundreds of **local jobs and millions in economic activity**, while stable, affordable homes improve workforce productivity and long-term economic mobility for residents
- **Collective Action**: Coordination of **70+ cross-sector partners** around shared goal breaks down siloes and **creates efficiencies** around affordable housing production.
- **Shifting Mental Models**: **Everyone** (developers, residents, cities, philanthropy, business, state leaders) **has a role to play** in affordable housing solutions.
- **Profile Building**: National media coverage (e.g., LA Times, Stanford Social Innovation Review, PBS Newshour) **elevates the Coachella Valley/Riverside County as a leader**, correcting decades of invisibility in state housing policy.
