



**5** PEOPLE PER WEEK ARE DIAGNOSED WITH HIV IN RIVERSIDE COUNTY<sup>4</sup>




	Unsafe Sex Among Gay, Bisexual, or Other *MSM	72.1%

	Risk Unknown or Other	8.8%




### HIGHLY EFFECTIVE HIV PREVENTION

Condoms<sup>1</sup>. Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP)<sup>2</sup>. Undetectable viral load. Harm reduction programs<sup>3</sup>.



### EARLY TREATMENT MEANS A LONGER LIFE YOU CAN'T TREAT THE UNDIAGNOSED

13% of HIV-positive residents don't know their status<sup>4</sup>. The earlier HIV is diagnosed, the better the chance of living a long and healthy life.


**60%** of people living with HIV/AIDS are diagnosed between the ages of 25 and 44<sup>4</sup>
