
Influenza Geographic Spread

Figure 1: Number of Influenza-related Deaths*




*Earliest date associated with the illness was used for cases without reported date of symptom

Within expected levels for this time of year


Figure 3: Percentage of <u>Influenza-like Illness</u> Visits Among Patients Seen by California Sentinel Providers
