- Brucellosis, animal (except dogs) (*Brucella* spp.) – List (e) (2)
- Campylobacteriosis (*Campylobacter* spp.) – List (e) (2)
- Chancroid (*Hemophilus ducreyi*) – List (e) (2)
- Dengue (dengue virus) – List (e)(2)
- Giardiasis (*Giardia lamblia*) – List (e)(2)
- Hantavirus Infections (hantavirus) – List (e)(2)

Changes

- Anthrax to Anthrax, human or animal (*B. anthracis*) – Urgency of reporting: List (e) (1)
- Avian Influenza (human) to Influenza, novel strains (human) – List (e)(1)
- Brucellosis to Brucellosis, human (*Brucella* spp.) – Urgency of reporting: List (e) (1)
- Hepatitis A, acute infection, by IgM antibody test or positive viral antigen test to Hepatitis A, acute infection – laboratory results as listed in the CDC/CSTE case definition
- Hepatitis B, acute infection, by IgM anti-HBc antibody test to Hepatitis B, acute infection – laboratory results as listed in the CDC/CSTE case definition
- Hepatitis C (see instructions in 2505 regulation) to Hepatitis C - laboratory results as listed in the CDC/CSTE case definition
- Measles (Rubeola), acute infection, by IgM antibody test or positive viral antigen test to Measles (Rubeola), acute infection – laboratory results as listed in the CDC/CSTE case definition.
- Tularemia to Tularemia, human (*F. tularensis*) – List (e)(1)
- Viral Hemorrhagic Fever agents to Viral Hemorrhagic Fever agents, human or animal, (VHF) – List (e) (1)
