SECTION 1. All city departments and agencies are encouraged to: (A) Promote and support active transportation and physical activity; (B) Support joint use of facilities throughout communities in Riverside County which enhance physical activity; and (C) Develop policies to provide access to healthy and affordable foods; and

SECTION 2. The City of Lake Elsinore will work with other cities, County departments, community partners, and regional agencies to adopt preventive measures, develop initiatives and programs to fight obesity and chronic disease, and create or support existing coalitions, such as the Riverside County Health Coalition, which collectively advance community health and wellness.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption.
