Rallying Around Sisters: Redefining and Strengthening the Village

In 2018, recognizing an alarming statewide gap in Black infant mortality, the state Legislature passed the Budget Act of 2018 which included the establishment of the California Perinatal Equity Initiative (PEI) within the Department of Public Health.

In recognition of persistent racial inequities in infant mortality, the California State Legislature established the Black Infant Health (BIH) Program in 1989 to identify and implement strategies to improve birth outcomes for Black mothers and babies. BIH was then supplemented by the Perinatal Equity Initiative in 2018 to further expand on these strategies.

Both Riverside University Health System-Public Health (RUHS-PH) Perinatal Equity Initiative and the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health Perinatal Equity Initiative currently funds two community agencies Fatherhood Initiative Services Program Intervention and Community Doula Services Program Intervention to provide resources and services to bridge the gap to Black Infant Health services. Both PEI interventions utilize a community advisory board for program support and direction.

RALLYING AROUND SISTERS: REDEFINING AND STRENGTHENING THE VILLAGE TAKES CENTER STAGE IN THE INLAND EMPIRE

In a groundbreaking initiative, Rallying Around Sisters, a movement dedicated to redefining and strengthening the village for Black birthing people, is making waves in Riverside and San Bernardino counties. The campaign aims to bring attention to the unique experiences of Black mothers and families and promote positive change through targeted interventions.

Supported by the Perinatal Equity Initiative (PEI) and complementing the Black Infant Health (BIH) Group Model, Rallying Around Sisters is a powerful force in reshaping the birthing experience for Black communities.

"Our Inland Empire community is a vital part in helping us highlight the resources available to Black women who are pregnant and recently given birth." says Elizabeth Amezcua, Project Coordinator for the Perinatal Equity Initiative for San Bernardino County Department of Public Health.

BIH, a group-based approach, provides essential services, information, and social support to Black mothers. A 2021 statewide survey of the program found that:

- 94.5% of BIH participants agreed that the program helped them manage stress and build stronger social connections
- 95.7% of BIH staff said the program is connecting participants with the services they need in regards to improving health outcomes
- 99.2% of BIH participants said they would refer a friend, colleague, or relative to BIH

By funding the Fatherhood Initiative Services Program Intervention and Community Doula Services Program Intervention, PEI is implementing evidence-based and informed interventions that will further provide resources and services to bridge the gap to BIH services.

Quarterly, PEI convenes parents, community members, Community Based Organizations (CBO's), perinatal providers, doulas, midwives, mental health providers, and students with a vested interest in seeing better perinatal outcomes for Black women/birthing families in the Inland Empire.

By joining the campaign, PEI can attract more participants into our program and improve the health outcomes of Black births in our region." says Stephanie Bryant, Maternal, Child, and Adolescent Health Director for Riverside University Health System-Public Health.

Invest in your physical and mental health with daily movement, hydration, balanced diet, journaling and therapy.

Invite the father/support person in to the experience and share how he can support you and baby.

Create your birthing experience. Your birth team may have an ob/gyn, midwife, doula and your personal village.

Know your options in paying for expenses. Requests 'doula funds' as a shower gift, speak with your insurance provider of your benefits and utilize HSA funds. Consider a free doula through utilizing Medi-Cal benefits. Doulas can be requested through your health care plan.

Create a birth plan with your village and birth educator. Childbirth courses are helpful in understanding medical terms and teaching your partner advocacy tactics.



Postpartum



Breastfeeding is an excellent way to feed and bond with your baby and has benefits for you too (you burn 500 calories each feeding)!

Prioritize postpartum physical and mental care through scheduling breaks, hygiene routines and light movement.

Rest is one of the best ways to recover. Schedule time with your village for rest, recovery and support of the baby.
