## **Prevention and Early Intervention Quarterly Collaborative Meeting**

### **Meeting Minutes**

**October 30, 2019**

**12:00pm – 2:00pm Rustin Conference Center**

- Diana Brown - Welcoming Message
- Introductions
  - Went around the room and all attendees introduced themselves and shared where they were from. We had providers and community members from all regions of the county.
- Program Presentation - Presentation: Creating Welcoming Environments for the People We Serve - Shannon McCleerey-Hooper, Consumer Affairs Manager
  - Asked to differentiate between being a consumer and being a patient.
- Program Highlights - Teen Suicide Awareness & Prevention Program - Rebecca Antillon
  - This PEI Funded program is now at 14 school districts throughout Riverside County.
  - Noah and Nathan, students, shared their experience being involved in the program.
  - Surveys are distributed to all students in the schools and they are receiving 200-400 surveys back from each school site. These surveys are distributed to get a snapshot from the student body to see the success of the program as well as making sure the program is reaching all the students.
  - Suicide Prevention Policies in place in all schools
    - AB2246 - Staff Training, Parent Education & Student Management.
    - AB1767 - Requires school districts to have comprehensive suicide prevention policy targeting prevention, intervention and post-vention strategies for K-12 grades.

- AB2639 - Update policies every 5 years.
  - AB2022 - Provide information on Mental Health Services to parents and students.
  - SB972 - Schools to add Suicide Prevention Hotline & prevention services on school ID badge.
- Suicide Prevention Week Activities Sept. 8<sup>th</sup> - 14<sup>th</sup>
  - Riverside County Board of Supervisors issued a Proclamation to Public Health & Behavioral Health for Suicide Prevention Week
  - Hosted Self-Care activities for employees throughout the week at the Rustin Conference Ctr. in collaboration with Culture of Health Ambassadors.
    - Similar activities were hosted throughout the county at various locations.
  - Suicide Prevention Walk was September 10<sup>th</sup> in downtown Riverside.
  - We received 30 submission for the Suicide Prevention Mini Grant. 15 total mini grants were awarded, (8 Desert Region, 4 Mid-County region & 3 Western Region).
    - With the mini grant the providers will be doing different activities utilizing the Each Mind Matters toolkit created to increase awareness educate about suicide prevention.

  - Audience question: How many calls are received each year at the SP HelpLine
    - On average 7000 calls are received to 951-686-HELP
    - In 2018 there was 150 active rescues.
- PEI Provider Updates
  - New Providers
    - African American Mental Health Coalition, Linda Hart, CEO - Community Mental Health Promotion Program in Riverside specifically addressing the African American Population.
    - Borrego Health, Angel Community Mental Health Program working with LGBTQ community as well as Trans Youth and HIV Positive adults over 65 in the Desert Region.
  - Perris Valley Filipino-American Assoc., Mila Banks
    - Recently held elections for new leadership team.
    - Hosted Health Fair on October 5<sup>th</sup>. Cup of Happy was in attendance and gave a presentation. It was a successful event to educate teens & parents on homelessness and human trafficking. They are hoping to host this event yearly.
- Community Roundtable/Announcements
  - NAMI Advocacy Regional Meeting will be Jan. 21, 2020 in Coachella at UCR Palm Desert Campus, anyone interested can attend.

- PEI has built a trainer team in the last year that offer safeTALK, ASIST & Mental Health First Aid to the community at no charge. We are currently in the process of developing a Draft plan/Strategic plan for Suicide Prevention countywide. Getting near the final stage of reviewing data and gathering information from our stakeholders. Once this plan is in place we will be creating a Suicide Prevention Coalition that will be in charge of implementing the strategic plan. Anyone who is interested can join and be a part of this Coalition.
