COVID Vaccination & TB Test

- COVID mRNA vaccines, TST, and IGRA Follow-up | Dear Colleague Letters | TB | CDC
 - "COVID-19 vaccination should not be delayed because of testing for TB infection.
 Testing for TB infection with one of the immune-based methods, either the
 <u>tuberculin skin test (TST) or an interferon release assay (IGRA)</u>, can be done
 before, after, or during the same encounter as COVID-19 vaccination.
