

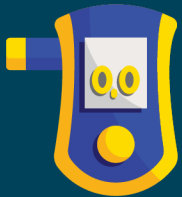

- The state enforces a Zero Tolerance Law, meaning any alcohol in a minor's system can result in a DUI charge.
- It is essential for young drivers and their parents to understand that even small amounts of alcohol can impair driving abilities, making it crucial to avoid alcohol altogether when behind the wheel.
