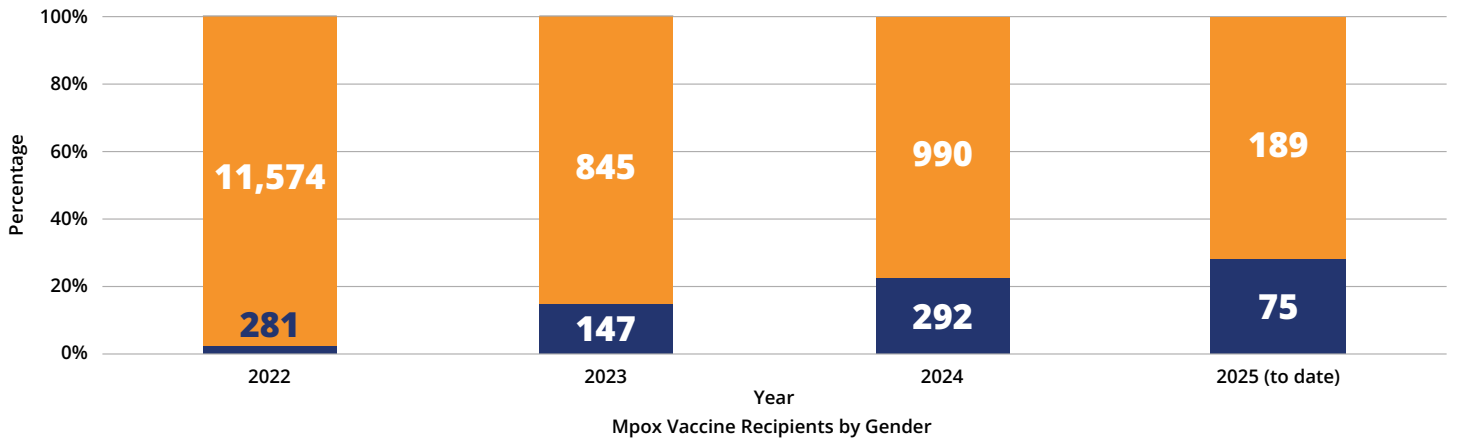


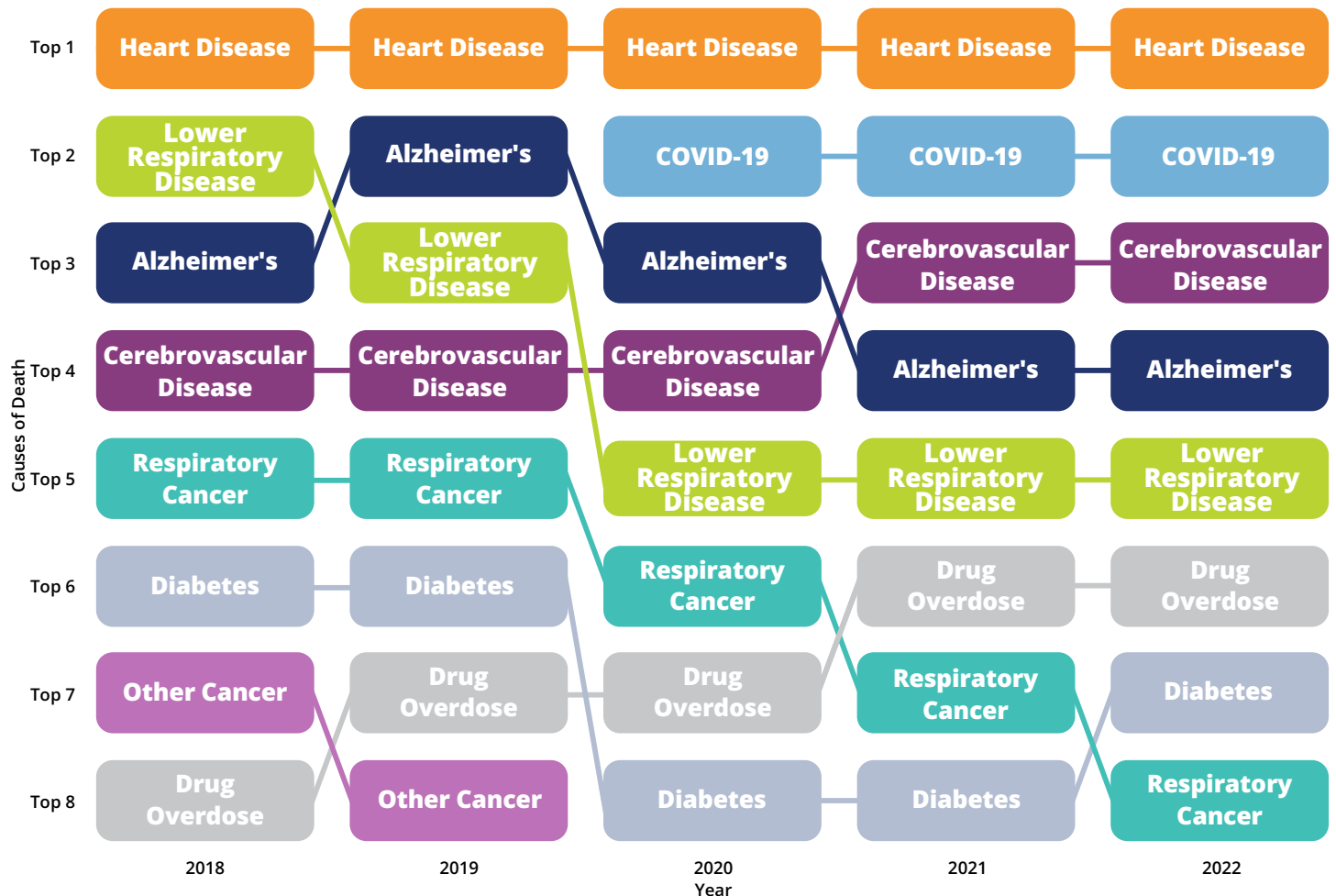
Females Account for a Growing Share of Mpox Vaccinations in Riverside County

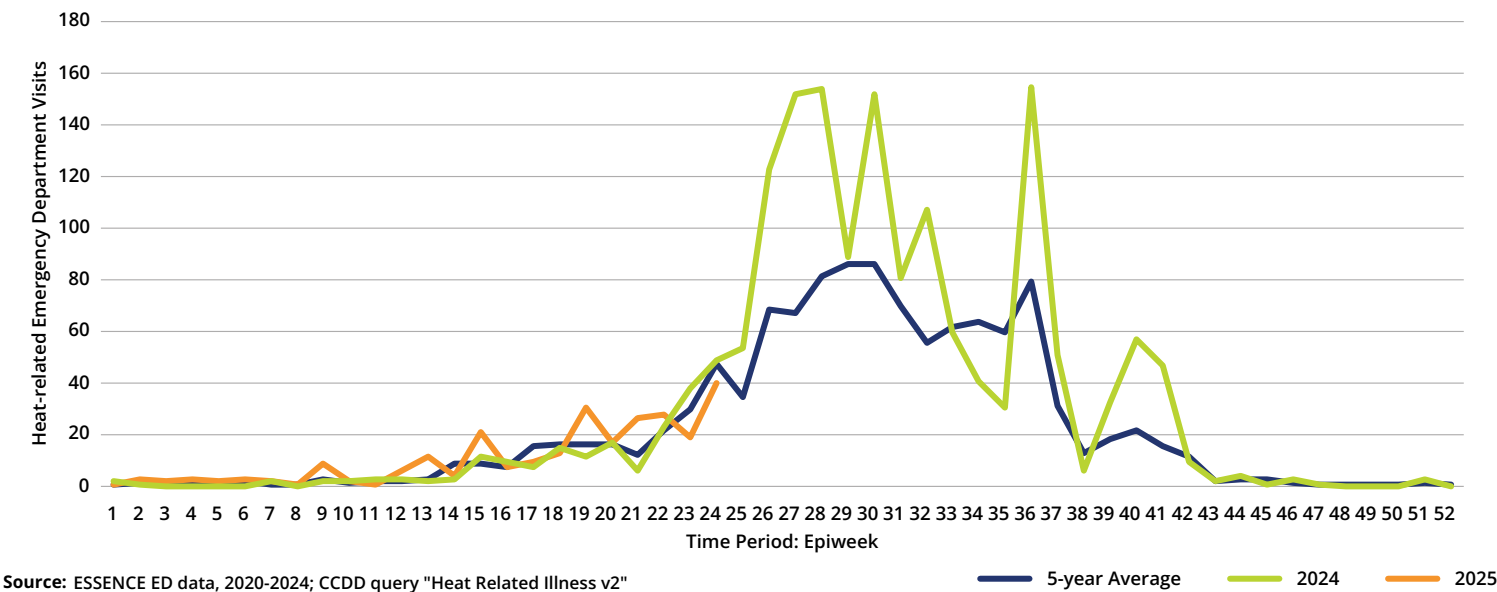
Top 8 Causes of Death by Year, Ranked by Count, 2018-2022



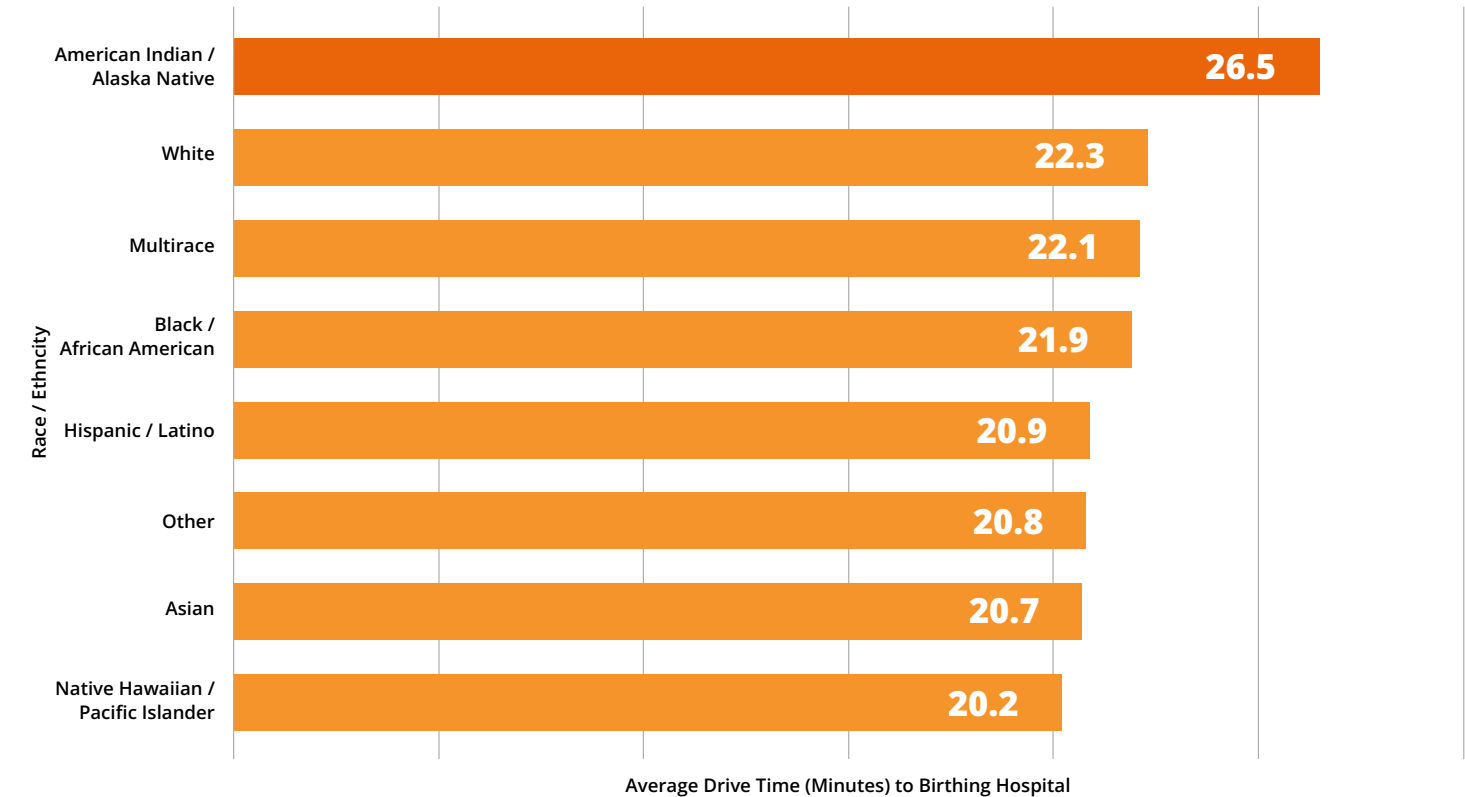

Heat-related Emergency Department Visits by Epiweek: 2025 Year-to-date vs 2024 and 5-year Average (2020-2024)



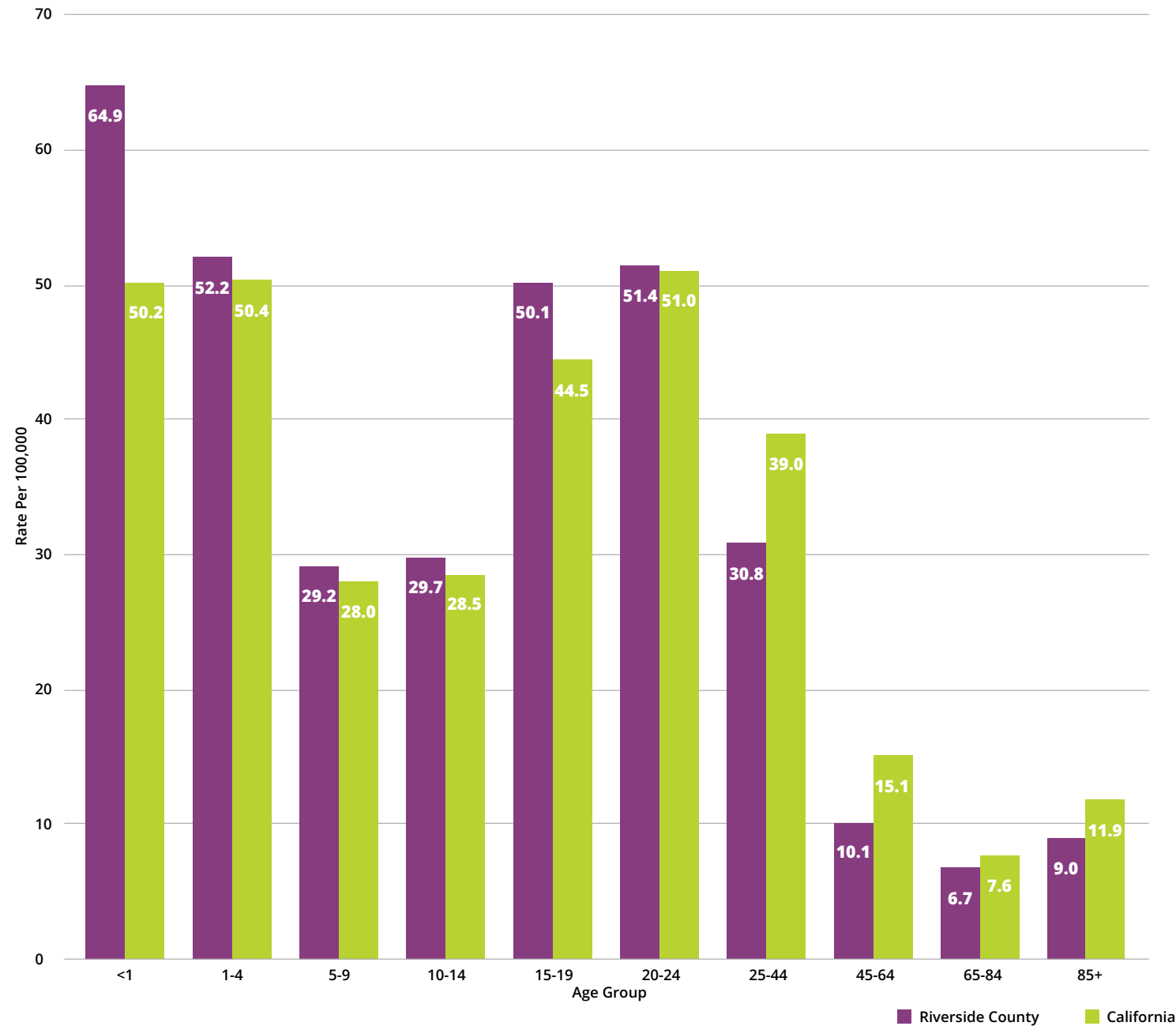
Between 2018 to 2023, American Indian / Alaska Natives Had the Longest Average Drives to the Hospital for Childbirth at 26.5 minutes
