

Figure 6: Fatal Overdoses by Gender 2023








Figure 8: Count Overdose Deaths* among People Experiencing Homelessness by Year





Figure 12: Fatal Overdoses by Race / Ethnicity and Drug Type *

Figure 13: Drug-Related Emergency Department Visits (All Drugs) by Gender September 2023




Figure 14: Count of Drug-Related Emergency Department Visits by Age (All Drugs) September 2023





Figure 15: Count of All Drug VS Opioid-Related Visits To the Emergency October 1, 2022 - September 30, 2023
