Partner Program Highlight IEHP Academic Detailing

The IEHP Academic Detailing program offers private (one-on-one) detailing sessions, resources, and information on safe opioid prescribing for chronic pain. Topics include: naloxone, opioid tapering, interpreting urine drug screening (UDS), recognizing opioid use disorder, medication assisted treatment, and more.

IEHP also started a Provider Fax Blasts campaign, where they identify members every quarter who are at risk of an opioid overdose due to high morphine milligram equivalents (MME) per day or are receiving concurrent benzodiazepine and opioid medications. Once identified, IEHP will conduct outreach to their providers to consider the addition of a naloxone prescription. They also identify members who are continually on high dose opioids and recommend that providers mitigate overdose risk and closely monitor patients under their care who cannot taper their dose. Prescribing naloxone is also recommended for these patients.

These outreaches have been impactful in an increased fill rate for naloxone compared to previous years without the provider outreach. Additional information about the Academic Detailing program is also included in the Provider Fax Blasts.
